



Guide To Save Six Day Delivery Petition

With continued attacks on Saturday delivery and the future of the Postal Service at stake, the time to step up and let Congress hear America's voice is now. Building off the success of the Save America's Postal Service rallies, we are now rolling out the Save Six Day Delivery petition drive. This petition drive will continue to engage the public to support our struggle. Our goal as an organization is to send the Joint Select Committee on Deficit Reduction, or the "super committee," the message to maintain six-day mail delivery.

To begin, you and your branch should immediately begin gathering petitions in your community. Make sure to reach out to your best activists and begin developing a strategy for reaching your branch's signature goal of ten times your membership. For example, if your branch has 500 members, you should gather 5,000 signatures.

Plan at least one large event each week to gather signatures in your community. The events should take place in areas that will receive lots of attention from the public.

Immediately after completing a petition drive, please mail your petitions to NALC Headquarters. NALC will organize the petitions and mail them to the appropriate Congressional office.

NALC Headquarters will be processing the petitions and assisting activists in the field organizing to gather signatures. Please note the key dates below:

- **November 14:** Petitions are due at NALC headquarters.
- **November 16:** Advertisements listing the number of signatures gathered as well as the co-sponsors to H Res 137 will be placed in targeted newspapers in DC and across the country.
- **November 23:** Super Committee submits recommendations to Congress.

The www.saveamericaspostalservice.org website will be the central location for information and assistance about the petition drive. There will be an online version of the petition available on the website where you can direct your members as well as the general public.
